ARTICLE I

(WISE (Women in Science and Engineering)

The name of this Women in Science and Engineering - WISE

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

The club has been organized to raise awareness and investigate problems concerning Women in sciences and engineering. This club will host field trips, have guest speakers, and provide a space to learn and discuss women in science and engineering.

ARTICLE III

(Authority)

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IV

(Membership)

Membership is open to all SBCC students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

ARTICLE V

(Meetings)

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC-217.

ARTICLE VI

(Officers)

President – Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings.

Vice President – Supports the president, takes over in their absence.

Secretary – Records minutes of club meetings.

Treasurer – Keeps financial record.

Communications Director – Manages communications and outreach.

ARTICLE VII

(Elections)

Officers shall serve 2 term(s) and will be elected each fall.

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 65% of the Club
